Kelsey, 4th grade, 10: My invention would be small, blue, and it would make candy.



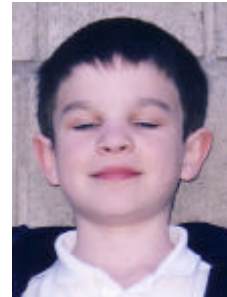
Loren, 5th grade, 10: My invention would be a three-foot cube, be camouflaged, and it would do anything anybody wanted.
