Dr. Gonsalves will administer the screening exam for students in grades 4-8 who are interested in participating in the terrific summer school courses offered on the CSUS campus. **Cost for the testing is only \$15.00** (Sorry, Dr. Jo had the cost wrong in the last memo!) and the course fees range from \$104-384, depending on the length of the course, with financial aid available for qualified students.
