These are mailed from the Brookfield office directly to the high school. Your child's application is not complete without these letters on file. **Parents and students are responsible for obtaining and completing all other application materials and meeting each school's stated deadlines.** Please give your child's teachers (and principal) the courtesy of enough time to compose a thoughtful letter of recommendation.

If your child will apply to one of the Catholic Prep High Schools, you MUST register your child to take the test at the "1st choice" school. The Placement Test is on Jan. 23 at 8:00AM.

Parents must call or email the high school admissions office in advance to register for the test.
