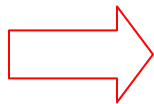


Thank you to the many families who donated to Operation Cratchit last week. Your generosity helped to give our less fortunate neighbors a happy holiday season.

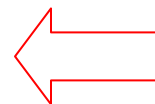
