To Parents and Students:

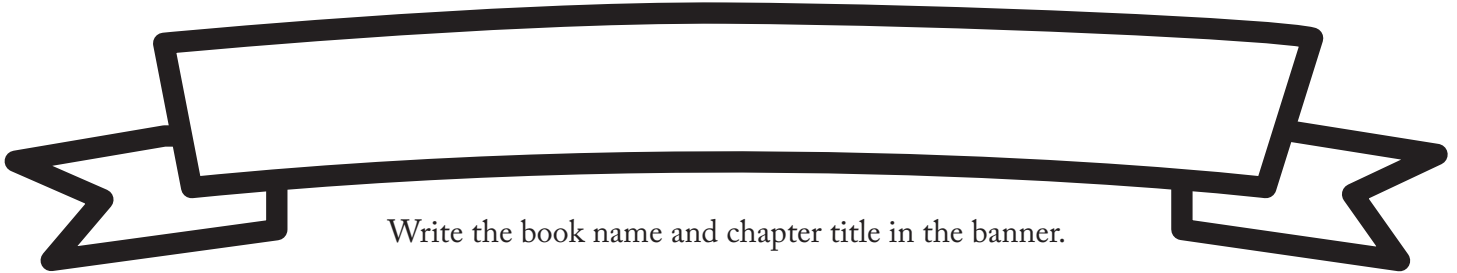
